Why should someone consider applying to the Doctor of Ministry in Preaching degree program at Aquinas Institute?

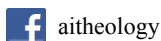
The Church is well-served by the holistic emphasis Aquinas puts on the important ministry of the preached Word. Students are formed to preach in both word and deed.
